Questions to Ask Your Child

Questions to Ask About a Character Who Gets Along

- What did the character do that showed that he/she was not getting along with others at the beginning of the story?
- What happened to the character because he/she did not get along with others?
- Did the character learn to work and play nicely with the other characters in the story?
- Did the character learn to take turns and/or share with others?
- Did the character try to talk about problems and disagreements instead of fighting?
- Did the character try to make things cleaner and safer?
- How did the character feel when he/she learned to get along with others?
- Do you feel happier when you get along with others?
- What are some of the things you might do to show you like to get along with others?
